

LAFAYETTE COUNTY TRAILS MEETING
NOVEMBER 3, 2015
3:30 P.M.
COUNTY BOARD ROOM

Present: Committee Chairman Wolfe; Supervisors Wiegel and Garthwaite; Lee McCarville, Duke Ruf, Lauree Aulik, Tom Jean and County Clerk Bawden.

The meeting was called to order at 3:30 P.M. by Mr. Wolfe. He asked if the meeting was properly posted. Ms. Bawden verified the meeting was posted at the Courthouse, the Darlington Municipal Building, Memorial Hospital, on the county website and sent to the press.

Motion by Mr. Wiegel, second by Mr. Garthwaite to approve the agenda as presented. Voice vote, motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Wiegel, second by Mr. Garthwaite to approve the minutes of May 7, 2015 as printed. Voice vote, motion carried.

Discussion and Possible Action on Review of New County Trail Maps: Mr. Wolfe had new trail maps printed before Ms. Ritchie left employment. Have been using 18.2 miles ATV trails. ATV organizations will check on trails from Hwy. 23 to Ranch House and Hwy 23 to rec trail. They will only be requesting funds for miles we actually have for next year. Snowmobile trails are receiving funds for 92.5 miles. Mr. Wolfe feels we need to GPS the routes for accuracy. We could possibly work with other clubs to make up miles.

Belmont to Platteville Bike Trail: Tom Jean stated the design has been approved. He is working with a committee on this project. The biggest hurdle right now is funding. This project has gone from \$1.2 million which is totally funded (we've gotten \$996,000 of federal money and \$249,000 from the DNR). The initial grant of \$1.2 million was funded and that is the way the County Board agreed to sponsor this. Since it's been going on so long it will now cost about \$2 million.
